ABOUT THE GIHSN

The Global Influenza Hospital Surveillance Network (GIHSN) is a network of sentinel hospitals identifying and characterizing acute respiratory infection cases on a systematic way and according to a similar protocol (see more details on www.gihsn.org).

This network currently consists in 100+ hospitals in 20+ sites worldwide and collects every year data from thousands of cases combining clinical data, virological data and virus genome sequencing.

It is co-funded by local authorities and by the Foundation for Epidemiology, established in 2014, which provides private sector catalytic funding under the format of grants.

The SARS-Cov2 pandemic further demonstrated the value of such resilient network driven by site empowerment, use of existing local infrastructure combined with capacity building, cross-country open collaboration and data ownership by sites.

Scope has been enlarged progressively to focus on various respiratory viruses including SARS-Cov2. This platform features are particularly aligned with current pandemic preparedness discussion and is open to opportunities for synergies.
